

ABOUT THE CAPACITY BUILDING PROGRAMME (CBP)

The Karnataka State Tribal Research Institute (KSTRI), under the Department of Tribal Welfare, Government of Karnataka, is pleased to announce a 10-day Capacity Building Programme on Research Methodology, exclusively designed for Scheduled Tribe (ST) research scholars. This intensive programme aims to empower ST scholars who are currently pursuing M.Phil., Ph.D., or Post-doctoral research by equipping them with essential research skills, tools, and methodologies to conduct high-quality academic research, particularly in the domains relevant to tribal communities and social sciences.

THE OBJECTIVES OF THE PROGRAMME

Scheduled to be held at the KSTRI premises in Mysuru, the programme will cover a comprehensive curriculum that includes both theoretical and practical components of research methodology. Participants will be trained in the basics of Quantitative and qualitative research techniques, Research design, Sampling methods, Data collection tools, Statistical analysis using software like SPSS and R, and Plagiarism ethics. Special sessions will focus on conducting literature reviews, Managing references using software tools, and improving academic writing and publication skills. Additionally, the programme will emphasize research in tribal studies, fieldwork methodologies, and culturally sensitive research practices.

RESOURCE PERSONS AND METHOD OF COURSE

The programme will be facilitated by distinguished academicians, research methodologists, statisticians,

and field experts from premier institutions across India. Through interactive lectures, group discussions, hands-on activities, and peer-to-peer learning, the programme aims to build participants' competence and confidence to undertake rigorous academic research. Scholars will also gain insights into publishing in reputed journals, presenting papers at academic forums, and developing impactful research proposals.

In recognition of the participants' commitment, KSTRI will provide certificates upon successful completion of the programme. Participants will be provided with a comprehensive research toolkit, which includes reading materials, templates, and digital resources to support their on-going research work. Food and accommodation will be arranged for outstation participants, and eligible participants will be reimbursed for travel expenses as per institutional norms.

Preference for selection will be given in the following order:

- First Preference Candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribes (ST) who are conducting research on Tribal communities.
- 2. Second Preference Candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribes (ST) who are conducting research on non-tribal communities or topics unrelated to tribal issues.
- **3. Third Preference** Non-ST candidates conducting research related to Tribal communities.

Interested and eligible candidates must fill out the application form (format attached herewith) and have it duly forwarded by the competent authority of their affiliating institution. A scanned copy of the completed and forwarded application form must be sent via email to: kstriseminar@gmail.com

Short listed participants will be informed by 31st July 2025.

Applications received after the deadline will not be considered.
